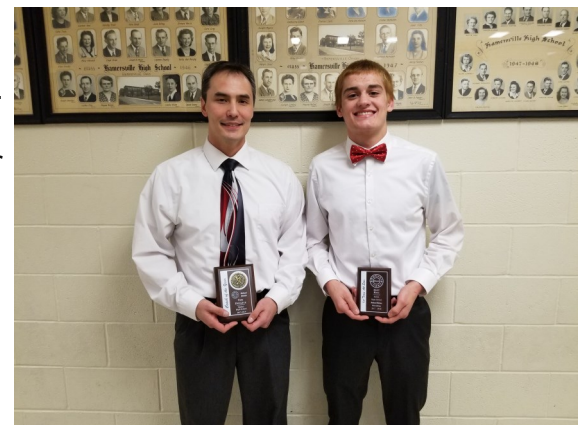

## Wrestlers at State

Bethel-Tate's outstanding wrestling season was capped off with not one, but TWO State Placers at the OHSAA State Wrestling Tournament on March 10 in Columbus. Senior Matt Hall stood on the final podium with a 7th place finish at state in the 152-pound division. Hall won a league, sectional, and district title before placing at state. Hall will go down as one of the most successful and decorated wrestlers in Bethel-Tate history. Trey Sander had a huge junior year in 2017-2018. Sander, a sectional champion, won a team-high 51 matches this season. He finished 7th in the state tournament in the 120-pound weight class. Sander and Hall are the first multiple state placers in one season since 1993 for Bethel-Tate. Congrats to Hall, Sander, and Coach Tom Donahue on another great season!

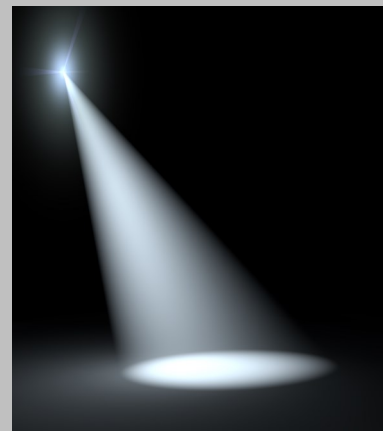
## Student Spotlight
