## Notification of School Closing

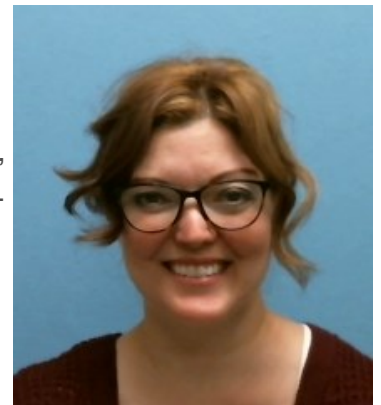

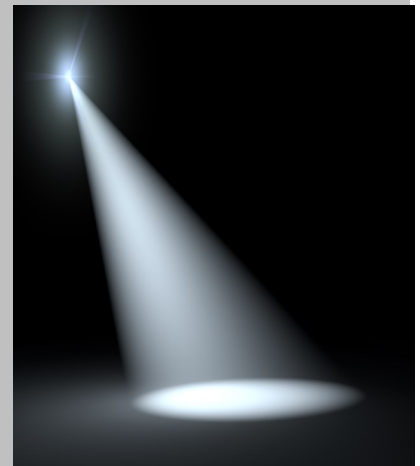
