

## Grades 6-12 Remote Learning Program

Bethel-Tate Local Schools is proud to collaborate with Apex Learning to offer our 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students a personalized online learning platform. By choosing our remote learning option, students will have a Bethel-Tate teacher supporting their learning goals and meeting their needs for remediation or acceleration of content. This program is designed to give each student a unique experience for success, while giving the teacher flexibility to meet each student where they are individually. Courses are credit-bearing digital curriculum for core and elective classes. Students in grades 6-12 can take courses online for original credit or for credit recovery toward grade-level advancement or high school graduation. The program is designed for an adult family member, also called a “learning coach,” to assist and guide the child daily or as needed.

The registration fee for the Apex Learning program is \$125 for the semester. Students can take up to 7 courses per semester for this fee. There will be no additional cost if a student continues Apex Learning for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year.
